Advance Care Planning – Process to refer your Patients for Advance Care Planning Facilitation

Hurley has been working with various health care institutions to improve the process for patients to complete advance care planning. All local health care institutions will be using the same form. Hurley has 13 trained Advance Care Planning Facilitators including all ACE nurses that are available to assist patients in completing the advance directive.

Following proper completion, the document will be uploaded to EPIC and to Great Lakes Health Connect electronic system. The patient will also be given acopy to share with their physician. A free informational meeting is available for patients on the 2nd Friday of the month from 1pm to 2pm at the Genesys Hurley Cancer Institute. Special pocket referral note pads have been made to give to your patients to attend a free presentation or arrange for an individual appointment.



Clinical Documentation Tip of the Month

New and Improved process for answering queries using 'shared notes' in Epic

Physician queries are important in helping to fill the void in charting. The clinical documentation specialist-RN is your resource to identify the void and assist you with providing language to fill the void. The purpose of the query is to ensure the most accurate clinical picture is represented in the form of ICD-9-CM codes.

The new query will be a permanent part of the record and will be treated as a shared note. The documentation specialist will provide the clinical indicators along with a smart text option with a number of diagnoses related to the data; there will be a free text option available if none of the provided diagnoses are suitable. Remember to sign, not share the note after a diagnosis is provided. These shared notes will be located within your inbox for ease of access. Open your inbox, find the shared note, click edit, then complete and sign the note.
