## It's Time for Your Flu Vaccination!!!

For millions of people each year, the flu can cause a fever, cough, sore throat, runny nose, muscle aches, chills, and miserable days spent in bed instead of at work or school. However, you may not realize that more than 200,000 people are estimated to end up in the hospital from flu complications each year in the United States. And while unpredictable, the flu can be serious, even deadly. CDC estimates that between 1976 and 2007 annual flu-associated deaths in the United States ranged from a low of about 3,000 people to a high of about 49,000 people during the most severe season. CDC recommends that everyone 6 months and older get a yearly flu vaccine. The single best way to prevent the flu is to get a flu vaccine each season, even if you were vaccinated in prior years.

It's that time of year when we start preparing for the flu season. Hurley is proud to be partnered with Genesys and McLaren in making your vaccination and documentation process easier. This partnership will allow the sharing of data between each institution, which is now MANDATED by the Joint Commission and CMS. Your flu vaccination status must be updated for this flu season by March 31, 2016. The flu season is considered September, 2015 through March 31, 2016. Joint Commission and CMS are requiring all hospitals to know the Influenza immunization status of EVERY hospital employee, attending physician/allied health practitioner and/or licensed independent practitioner. Your vaccination information will be shared between all three medical centers to help everyone be in compliance.

All three hospitals will be administering free flu vaccines by **October 1, 2015**. Please feel free to contact any of the Employee Health Offices at McLaren or Genesys and Infection Control at Hurley to find out dates and times of vaccination clinics.

Hurley will be having two vaccination Clinics in the West Tower Lobby on 9/30 and 10/14. The clinics will be from 6:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. both days. Flu vaccine will also be available on each inpatient nursing unit. Just ask someone from nursing and they will obtain the form and vaccine for you. If you have taken your vaccination elsewhere please return the "Fax Blast" form that was sent out the week of 9/21/2015 to any of the three area hospitals.

## Annual Terry Thomas Conference & OB/GYN Residency Alumni Event

## Providers appear ready for ICD-10 according to latest end-to-end testing results

With less than one month until implementation, CMS says it's ready for ICD-10, and so are many providers, according to the results from the agency's final week of end-to-end testing in July.

The round of testing resulted in a similar acceptance rate to January and April testing weeks—but with the largest group of volunteers yet. Approximately 1,200 volunteers, from a broad range of provider, claim, and submitter types participated, including 493 who participated in previous testing weeks.

Testers submitted a record 29,286 claims and CMS accepted 25,646 of them, resulting in an 87% acceptance rate. This is a similar rate to previous testing weeks, and most rejections were the result of provider submission errors that would not occur with actual claims, according to CMS. Errors include incorrect NPIs or submitter IDs, invalid HCPCS codes, and dates of service outside of the range of testing.

Coding errors also led to rejections, with 1.8% of claims rejected due to an invalid ICD-10 code and 2.6% rejected due to an invalid ICD-9-CM code. Some of these errors may be due to providers intentionally submitting invalid codes to make sure the claim would be rejected.

Additionally, CMS rejected no claims due to front-end system issues and identified no new ICD-10-related issues in the Medicare fee-for-service claims processing systems.

Another successful round of testing is a good sign for the industry, but it doesn't mean every provider is truly ready for ICD-10. I've talked to providers who wanted to volunteer but weren't accepted or able to get a slot to participate with their clearinghouse.

In a poll last week of JustCoding.com readers, 26% said they were extremely confident their organization would be ready for ICD-10, while 23% said they were not confident at all. Another 52% responded they were only somewhat confident their organizations would be ready by October 1.

## EPIC UPDATE - Alcohol Withdrawal Assessment Tool Available

A new alcohol withdrawal assessment tool for internal medical floor patients went live on Sept 17, 2015 at Hurley Medical Center. This new tool called CIWA-AR (Clinical Institute Withdrawal Assessment of Alcohol Scale, Revised) helps in early identification and treatment of patients with early signs of withdrawal. A standard set of questions relating to alcohol use and symptoms of withdrawal are asked of patients with a history of alcohol use or who exhibit signs of withdrawal. As part of the assessment tool, the patients are scored on 10 symptoms of alcohol withdrawal and treated accordingly. Frequent scoring helps in escalating/deescalating treatment and also identifies patients who will be needing care in a critical care setting. The internal medicine PI committee was instrumental in rolling out this very well studied and validated tool. An estimated 500,000 episodes of alcohol withdrawal severe enough to require medical treatment occur each year in the United States.
