HMC Quality and Patient Safety ... Improving Care of Hospitalized Medical Patients

In January 2012 Hurley joined BCBS Michigan Hospital Medicine Safety



Consortium. The consortium consists of over 50 hospitals and works to improve the care of hospitalized adult medical patients.

Currently **Dr. Tabrez Shaik Mohammed**, Internal Medicine, is charged with leading the Venous Thromboembolism, and Peripherally Inserted Central Catheter (PICC) Initiatives. Our data from the past 12 months show:

Dr. Tabrez Shaik Mohammed

- 64% or 49 patients high risk for VTE without contraindication did not receive pharmacological or mechanical prophylaxis on admission.
- 61% or 118 patients at low risk for VTE received pharmacological prophylaxis on admission against the American College of Chest Physicians recommendations; our rate of VTE in hospital remains low (2 patients).
- 31% or 110 PICCs dwell times were <=5 days and 16 patients experienced upper arm DVT.

We encourage you to reach out to your Department Quality Improvement Committee and become involved in quality improvement initiatives like these. With the Epic upgrade in October we will be rolling out a new informational sidebar to assist providers with real time quality and safety compliance. The sidebar will highlight key quality and patient safety indicators in an actionable checklist right inside the patient's chart. Highly reliable safe patient care is our goal.

Meet Hurley's Geriatric Nurse Specialist Team

Hurley is proud to introduce our Geriatric Nurse Specialists. This team of specialty trained nurses oversees the care of all patients in our hospital (age 65 and older) specifically to identify those at risk for delirium, debility and decline. Older patients, admitted for one diagnosis or another, are at much greater risk for these secondary hospital acquired conditions much more so than younger adults.

The Geriatric Nurse Specialists work with the patients, families and bedside nurses to address and initiate things that will promote mobility, ensure good sleep and wake cycles, prevent skin breakdown, and identify medication concerns. They also work with bedside nursing and case management to insure hospitalizations and discharge transitions are as safe as possible for our seniors.

As the only area hospital providing this extra level of care for our geriatric patients, Hurley's Senior Center of Excellence continues to be the safest place for seniors.
